New Poll Data Showing Near Unanimous Support for Renewable Energy Development in Kansas

January 21, 2014 – On Thursday, January 23, The Wind Coalition and Climate and Energy Project will release new poll data showing that Kansans overwhelmingly support development of renewable energy resources in Kansas.

The poll, conducted in early January 2014 by North Star Opinion research, will show that Kansans support increasing renewable energy development and that the state's Renewable Portfolio Standard enacted in 2009 enjoys near unanimous support statewide.
